Welcome Back! The 2021-2022 PTO Board is excited about the upcoming school year! We are looking forward to seeing some familiar faces, as well as getting to know new parents this year as we work together to make our school a great place to learn!

PTO FRIENDSHIP GUIDE is a valuable resource for students, parents, and staff, which includes names, addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses of students, contact information for staff, as well as classroom rosters, our school activities, and additional key information. All families that return the attached form with a signature by September 3rd, will receive a copy of The Friendship Guide (very useful for play dates) at no cost. The school (teachers and office staff) are not allowed to give out student information to other parents so the Friendship Guide is our way to share information amongst ourselves. Please understand that in order to get the Friendship Guide put together, printed and bound in a timely manner, we need to have all forms in by September 3rd, in order for your family to be included in the Guide. PTO MANAGER is a system that allows us to send bulk emails to our school community informing parents of upcoming school events and volunteer opportunities. In our effort to be "green" most of our communication will be electronic. If you do not have access to a computer on a regular basis, please indicate that on the back of this form.

PTO CONTRIBUTIONS are used to fund programs for our children, to purchase materials for our school, and to provide classroom teachers with additional resources. While there is no cost associated with joining PTO, your child will benefit directly from your <u>tax-deductible</u> contribution. Most families with 1 or 2 children at OSE gave an average of \$20 last school year, though any amount is greatly appreciated. If you have questions about PTO's budget, please attend a PTO meeting, where the budget is reported upon monthly.

ROOM PARTY FEES are used to fund the room parties that occur for Harvest (10/28), Winter (12/17), and End of the Year (TBD). Children enjoy snacks, crafts, games, and social time at each party. The cost for Kindergarten through fourth grade is \$5.00 per child and \$15.00 per child in fifth grade. For those students in fifth grade, in addition to the funds used for the parties, there are additional expenses such as graduation, pool party, t-shirts, memory books, and other fun extras. You can also make <u>ONE PAYMENT</u> for your donation, your room party fees, AND your spirit wear (be sure to include a spirit wear order form, also found in the back to school folder, if you are ordering.) All checks can be made payable to OSE PTO. We are also able to accept cash. If you pay by check and your check hasn't been cashed within 4 weeks of sending it to school, please check with your child's teacher and/or email oseptoclovers@gmail.com to see if your check was received.
